GIFTS TO DISTRICT EMPLOYEES

Pupils and parents/guardians shall be discouraged from presentation of gifts to district employees. The board shall consider as always welcome, and in most cases more appropriate than gifts, the writing of letters to staff members expressing gratitude or appreciation.

This shall not be interpreted as intended to discourage acts of generosity in unusual situations, such as simple remembrances, expressions of affection or gratitude. These shall not be regarded as violations of this rule. (5133)
