G. <u>SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT</u> - Dr. Varley reported the following;

- The current enrollment of students is 984.
- HIB Report since the last meeting there were six incidents reported. Of those reported, one incident was found to be HIB, student to student conflict at Ridgedale Middle School.
- Drill Report Dr. Varley stated all drills were conducted in compliance with regulations.
- Teacher of the Year Dr. Varley began by welcoming everyone and reviewed the criteria for the
 nomination and selection of the Teacher(s) and Educational Support Professional of the Year. Dr.
 Varley and the building principals congratulated Ms. Michaela Harris, Ms. Christine Calafati, Ms. Lori
 Pompei and Ms. Jane Chonowski. All were awarded \$250 for use in their classrooms and flowers to
 celebrate their achievement.
- Special Services Presentation Mr. Gary Pascal, Supervisor of Special Education narrated a slide presentation on the district special education programs and services.
