SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT – Dr. Ronzitti reported on the following:

- Enrollment to date is 1,050 students.
- Two fire drills were conducted at all three schools in November 2009. A "shelter in place" drill was conducted at Briarwood and Ridgedale Middle School.
- Dr. Ronzitti reported that the Ridgedale Middle School Peer Leadership group held a luncheon with the local Senior Citizens group.
- Dr. Ronzitti gave a brief synopsis of events held at the annual New Jersey School Boards Association Conference. Mrs. Michalowski presented Dr. Carollo and the board with an award from the New Jersey School Boards Association Insurance Group. At the conference the district was recognized for their commitment and achievements in the area of safety in the workplace.
- Dr. Ronzitti gave a brief synopsis of the New Jersey Shade Tree Commission event he and Mr. Infantolino attended on behalf of the district. The district was recognized for the achievements in the area of environmental works, specifically the "One Day One School" Program.
- Dr. Ronzitti gave an update on consolidation. Nothing has been communicated to him since the last meeting and he would not speculate on how the recent gubernatorial election would affect the process.
- Dr. Ronzitti stated that Joanne Borin from New Jersey School Boards Association contacted him regarding the services offered by NJSBA.

- Dr. Ronzitti recognized Dr. Maricle for her recent charitable undertaking, specifically collecting holiday gift boxes for underprivileged children. Dr. Maricle thanked the administrative staff who made the event an overwhelming success.
- Dr. Ronzitti and Mr. Majeski thanked the students of Ridgedale Middle School and all the staff involved in raising money for the Lucas Scholarship Fund.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Policy – Mr. Gaffney stated the committee has not met since the last board meeting. Personnel – Mrs. Michalowski stated the committee has not met since the last board meeting.

Curriculum – Mr. DeCoursey stated that the committee met this evening to discuss approval of a new Gr. 6-8 Novel on the agenda this evening. The committee received an update on the new Ridgedale Middle School report card. The committee discussed preliminary information regarding a 1:1 middle school level laptop program obtained through a recent visit to Springfield Public School District by Dr. Ronzitti, Mr. Majeski and Mr. Christ. The committee reviewed a proposal from Total Training Solutions to provide various assessment and mentoring services paid through the ARRA/IDEA grant.

Finance and Facilities – Mr. Gaffney stated the committee had not met since the last meeting and will meet shortly after the new year to review the proposed 2010/11 school budget.

Transportation – Dr. Carollo stated the committee met on 10/21/09 to review the complaint and misconduct logs. The committee reviewed the current list of district vehicles and proposed the inclusion of two vehicles for the 2010/11 budget due to regulations which dictate the retirement of vehicles currently in the fleet. The committee reviewed the successful results of the recent semi-annual inspection of vehicles by the NJMVC.

Dr. Carollo read a prepared statement that will be submitted to the Florham Park Eagle thanking and recognizing the leadership and commitment of Mr. MacFarlane.
