## **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** – Dr. Ronzitti reported on the following:

- Enrollment to date is 1,042 students.
- Two fire drills were conducted at all three schools in May 2010. Brooklake Elementary School completed a "shelter in place" drill.
- Dr. Ronzitti gave an update on consolidation. There has been no communications on any level from the date of the last meeting. Dr. Ronzitti recognized Kings Super Market for their donation to the Special Education Program. The experience for the students was terrific.
- Dr. Ronzitti reported that there are six district employees in attendance this evening who
  are retiring and are being honored by the Board of Education. Dr. Ronzitti read the
  resolution that is on the agenda this evening. Each retiree was presented with a framed
  copy of the resolution and flowers.
- Various members of the public and the honorees excused themselves from the meeting.

Various members of the general public commented and presented the board with correspondence from "The Parents for Smaller Class Sizes". A member of the general public presented the board with an article from the NY Times regarding another NJ school district that is introducing engineering at the K-5 grade levels.
