#### 1. ADJUSTMENT FOR HEALTH BENEFITS

The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in health benefits.

#### 2. ADJUSTMENT FOR BANKED CAP

The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$62,898 for the purposes of Special Education-Out of District Placement Tuition Costs. The district intends to complete said purposes by June 2014.

## 5. Travel and Related Expense Reimbursements

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Board of Education Policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23B-1.2(b) provides that the board of education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2013-2014 school year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Florham Park School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2012-2013 school year at a sum of \$55,100; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

# 6. Professional Service Expenses

**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-5.2 (a) mandates boards to establish annually prior to budget preparation, for public relations and each type of professional service a maximum level of spending for the ensuing school year; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget includes the following appropriations

Financial Advisory	\$ 1,000
Professional Development	\$46,100
Transportation	\$ 5,000

**WHEREAS**, the administration needs to notice the board if there arises a need to exceed said maximums, upon which the board may adopt a dollar increase in the maximum amount through formal board action; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board and Administration wishes to minimize the amount of paperwork involved in this area;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Florham Park School District Board of Education establishes maximums for professional services listed above at a level of 120% of the amounts listed for the 2013-2014 school year.

#### 7. TAXING AUTHORITY

**WHEREAS**, the district has a taxing authority for the 2013 – 2014 school year composed of \$214,248 for health benefits adjustment and \$298,451 banked levy from previous budgets which are available to the district for the school budget for 2013-2014 in addition to the 2% increase over the prior year which totals \$301,018 resulting in a maximum tax levy available of \$15,864,626

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that there should be raised for the General Fund a tax levy of \$15,629,073 for the ensuing School Year (2013-2014).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the unused taxing authority of \$235,553 will be banked for potential use in the subsequent three fiscal years.
